

Chronotopography of the social uprising in Chile

“It is not about 30 pesos, it is about 30 years”
October 18, 2019 – October 18, 2021

There are many underlying reasons behind the social uprising in Chile on October 18th, 2019, but no one can tell exactly why it happened on that date in particular and not earlier.

For two years now, Chilean citizens have taken to the streets to demand the protection of their human and fundamental rights. Currently there is a Constitutional Convention that is starting to write a new constitution.

This chronotopography not only shows the events that have taken place in Chile since October 18th, 2019, but also their connection to the country's sociopolitical past, which unfolds the complexity of the underlying processes and the points of connection to German history.
